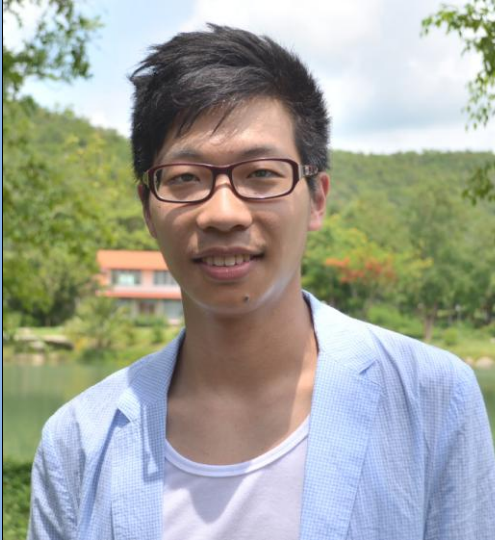


# Mr. Marco Zheda Mai, (China)
