GOALS

Help reduce the gap difference in terms of education between the rural and urban societies



Help our communities in good social engagement and teamwork towards a better approach in a lot of other social aspects in life

Unite the Malaysian YPA trainees from different YPA trainings into a common team, and map their various action plans.

OBJECTIVES

- To *improve the cost of living in terms of Education* for those people who come from remote areas that have never been exposed to a proper knowledge in **Mathematics and Science**
(Through fun-learning activities such as experiments and exhibitions, also introducing ethics of science and technology and critical thinking)
- To *help instill the Generic Skill Attributes* in terms of teamwork engagement between the volunteers and the respective community members

ACTIVITY

- The Youth volunteers will create an interactive module based on **Mathematics and Science** for the primary students
- The module should include some interesting games based on **Mathematics and Science** to ensure that the students are interested to join in
- Some outdoor games and arts based on **Mathematics and Science** will be held.
