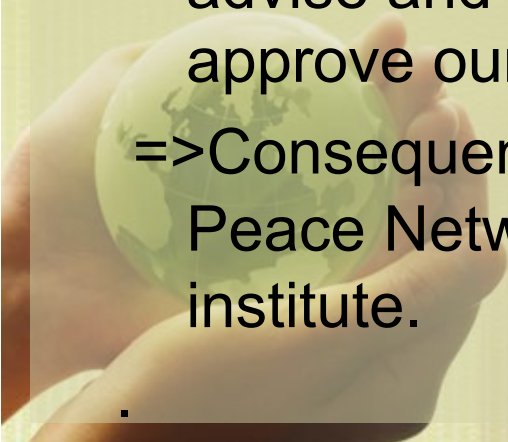

First Step: Create Cambodia Peace Network Team

- Forming a Permanent team that consist of **15 members**
(Significantly, we have to create a team before we conduct the workshop. Now we are already in group of 4, so we just need 11 candidates to become our members.
- Requiring to write **a formal report** to describe briefly about our team to our institute in order to get approval from institute.
- Need to inform lecturers in our department. They can advise and give feedback to our team before they approve our team to conduct the workshop.

=>Consequently, we can form a permanent Cambodia Peace Network Team under the authority of our institute.



How to become members of the team?

*every candidates that love peace and want to build peace concept with our Team can apply.

(The information about Team post on University board and through E-mail)

*Each candidate is only required to write a motivation letter around 1-2 pages that related to peace and sent it to us by Email.

Candidate can be approve to become the members of the Cambodia Peace Network Team base on their motivation letter.

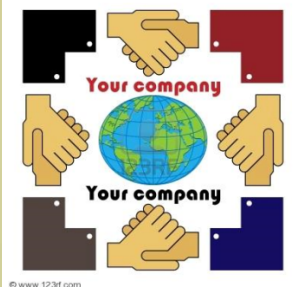
*The participants in 2nd UNESCO Youth Peace Ambassadors can join with us

Target: University Students

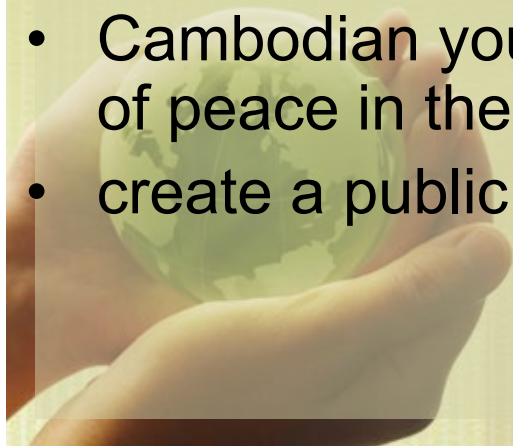
- age 18-24

- create a public opinion favourable of peace in our society



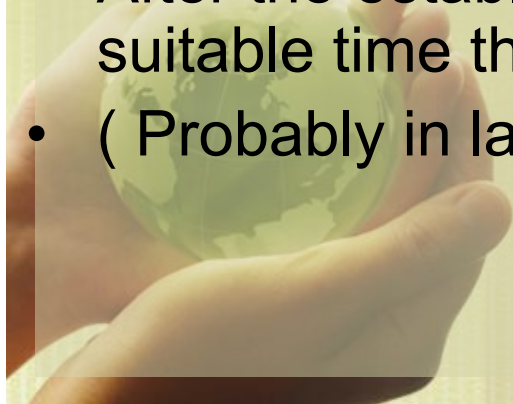


Project: Cambodia Peace Network

- (Probably in late 2011)



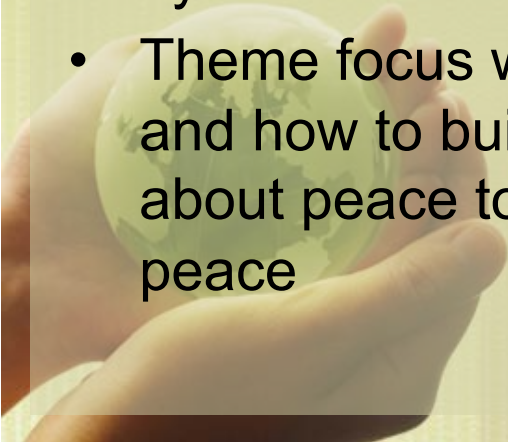
Project: Cambodia Peace Network

- Theme focus will be on the further development of positive peace and how to build peace in the minds in order to broaden knowledge about peace to all participants and make participants aware of peace



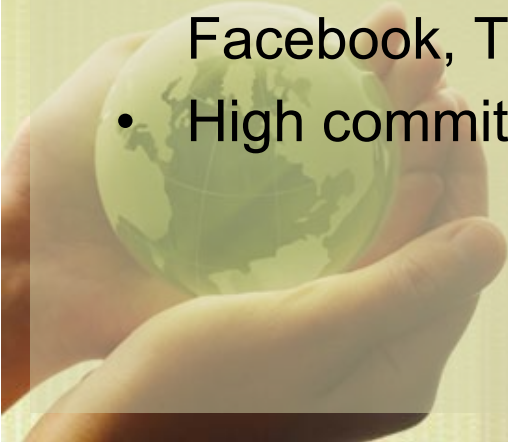


Project: Cambodia Peace Network
