# Background Information about Action Plan

- There are frequent migrations of disaster victims from
   Africa to Europe and within Europe
- Need to increase awareness about the several benefits of disaster risk reduction, sustainable development, the community-based approach to reducing risks influenced by international standards & best practice
- Develop and Improve cross-cultural disaster risks reduction knowledge and resilience planning
