How?



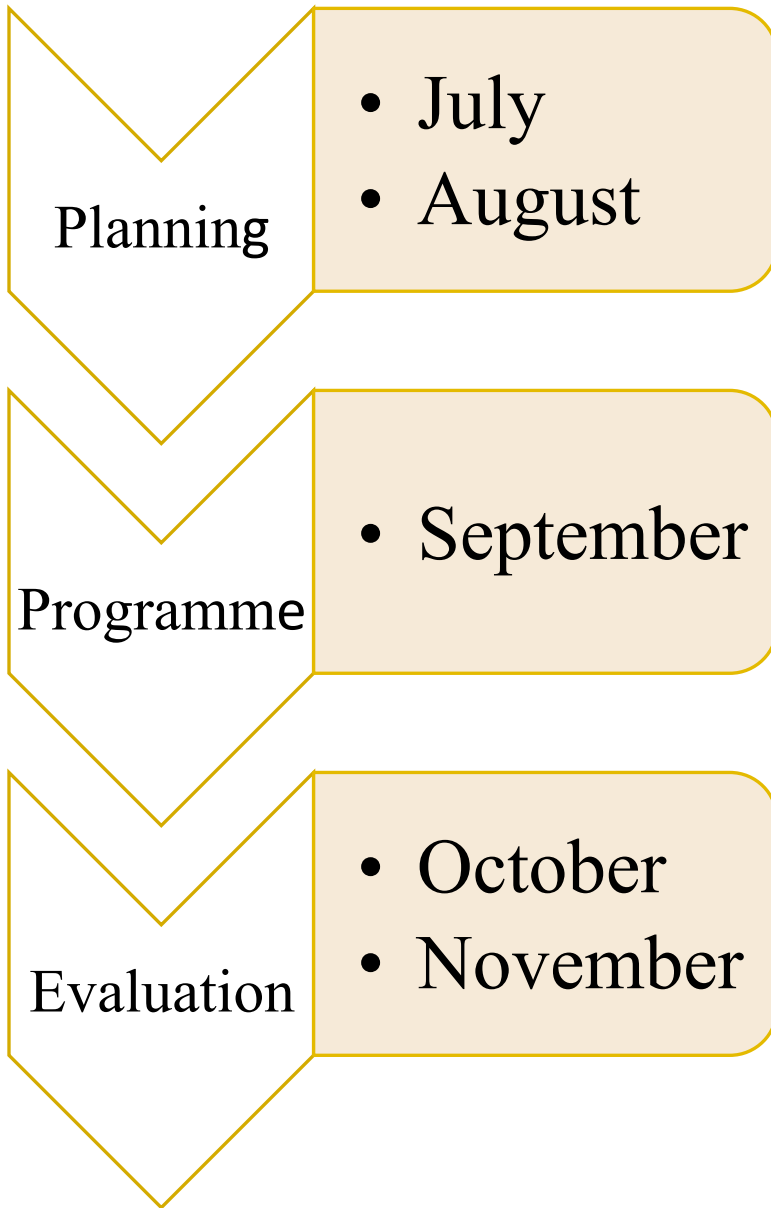
- A specific aim is to inform a disaster prone local community on the laws safeguarding disaster management.
