I worked as an active reporter in the agency (YJC,Young Journalists Club) for one year and more than 70% of my reports were published in different media. In October 2009, I went to Malaysia to continue my studies in USM in Management organizational behavior fields. In the March of 2010 I participated in the organization and execution of cultural event, called as Nowroz event, and it was repeated during March the following years. There were 350 people per meeting.

In November 2011, I attended the Third Youth Peace Ambassador Training Workshop in Penang and developed my action plan Art, the United Language workshop and exhibition. I became a UNESCO Youth Peace Ambassador when that was implemented.

Later on I become international coordinator at an event, Tomorrow's leadership summit, 2012. I also came up with the idea to establish an organization with the goal of promoting peace in the world with several other people to form the NGO United for Peace on Earth under the program of youth peace ambassadors international. Now we have 20 active committee members and many more supporters, and we have implemented several events and conferences.

Our NGO also is one of the partners of the road to Rio coalition. I am also country outreach of Iran in Rio+20,UN. In early 2012 I have attended the Fourth Youth Peace Ambassador Training Workshop in Hiroshima, as a speaker. I am also a member of Peace Museum of Tehran

Some of the activities of the United for Peace on Earth NGO:

- Regular visits to a Charity based Handicapped Children Association of Penang island, under the name of Free Hug;
- 2. Establishing fundraising programmes for the orphanages and handicapped;
- 3. Conducting research with the title of A New Method for Communicating with Mentally Challenged Children without Use of Language as Premier Tool. In this research the main goal is to achieve a new communication medium with mentally without use of language and try to compare it with the other existing methods on communicating with disabled children by doing a lot of literature review using internet and emedia based skills to achieve this;
- 4. Participating in Mothers day event in Straits Quay, the main goal of this is collecting donations and buying a physiotherapy machine for a handicapped children's center in Penang.
- 5. Organization of a workshop on peace communication, with the title of Pictologics and its Application on Peace Communication in collaboration with the School of Education, USM. The main goal of this workshop was to develop the effect of peace communication, using a new method in education called as Pictologics. The whole income of this workshop was directed to Penang Handicapped Children Center, in order to help them provide the demanded physiotherapy device.
- 6. Our NGO is in a coalition The Road to Rio+20 UN and we teach books of Rescue Mission published by UNICEF to the orphanages in order to socialize them and make them aware of their surroundings and the world as well as make them into be active environmentalists.
- 7. We are planning to organize a stakeholder roundtable in Kuala Lumpur to gather all the people and organizations who work with special needs education to organize them and trying to advance special needs education.
