In the Philippines, bullying is a very common issue, especially inside the school.

Since the statistics were quite alarming, this prompted the House of Representatives to approved a bill requiring elementary and secondary schools to include and implement antibullying policies in their students. To monitor its effectivity, the schools are obligated to submit and report incidents to the DepEd.

According to the Republic Act 10627 or the Anti-Bullying Act of 2013 was signed into law by Former President Benigno Aquino III in September 6, 2013. the law requires all elementary and secondary schools in the country adopt an anti-bullying policy. According to a study conducted on 2008 by the Britain-based Plan International, 50% of school children in the Philippines experienced bullying either by their teachers and their peers.
