Thus, Hibakusya (A-bomb survivors) have sent a message

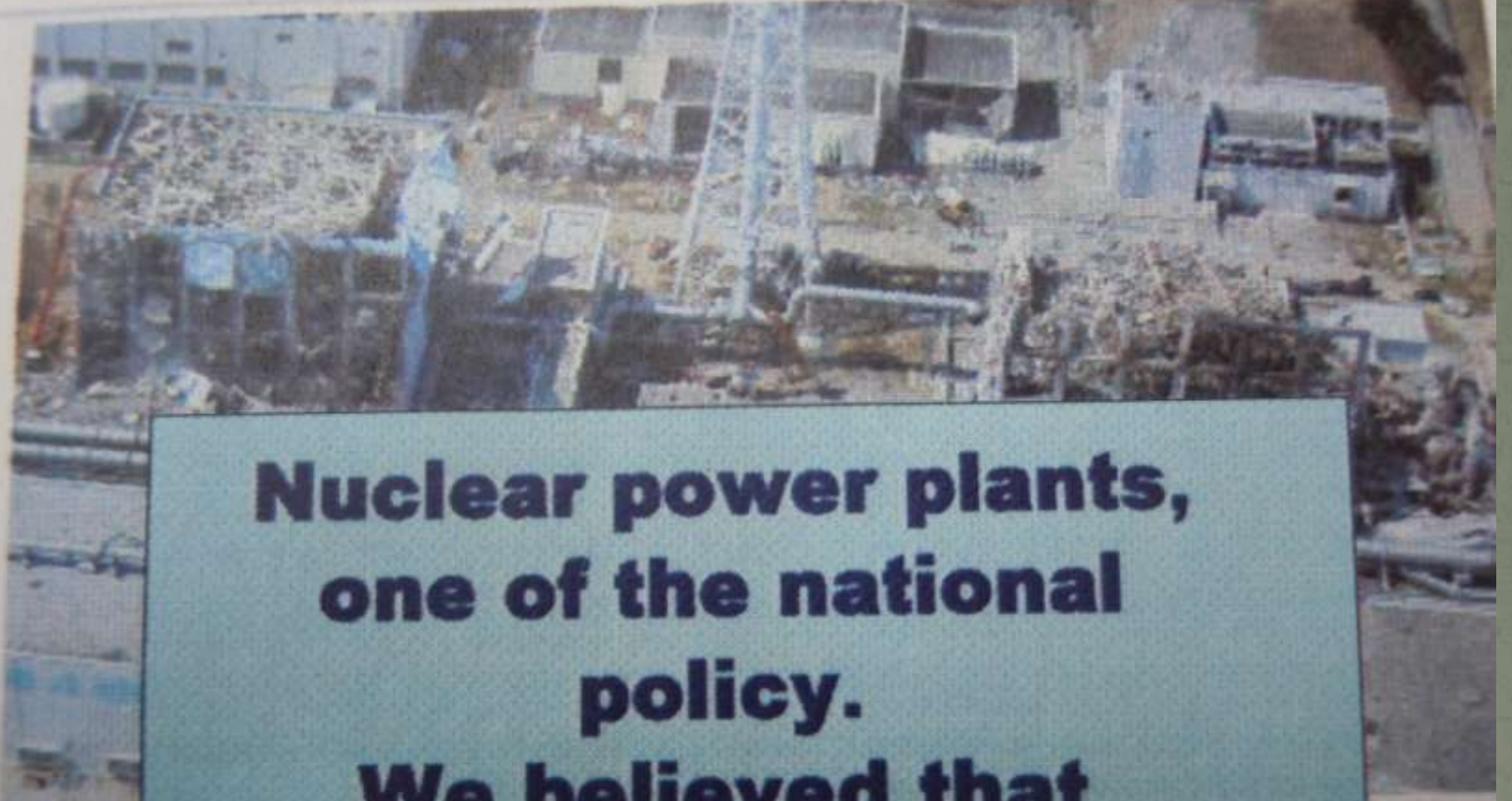
“No more else should ever have to suffer like us”
