






Operating System Architecture of Nenasa Education Channel

- Facilitate the Initiative by selecting the schools and assisting with the distribution of the television sets and the satellite receiver equipment.
 - Providing the National Institute of Education with a list of teachers for lesson preparation and production of content.
 - Overall administration of Nenasa channel



- Provide a dedicated channel to the MOE to transmit Nenasa, Free of Charge
- Import and install 2000 TV's and satellite receiver sets to selected schools, Free of Charge
- Provide support to the NIE to build capacity (supporting for training and capacity building)
- Infrastructure upgrades to equipment at the NIE
- Support the Learning Management System development

Schools Connected

- 872 Schools across all 9 provinces
- 28 Teacher training colleges
- 1100 new schools will be connected to Nenasa network during 2012/2013
- Reaches
 - 1,400,000 students
 - 150,000 high level school teachers
 - Close to 50,000 high level education administrators
