SOCIAL PROBLEM

Almost 39 million urban poor in Metro Manila were relocated to the countryside since 2003*.

(Some agreed to go and some did not!)

Informal settlers from different parts of the country come to Manila to look for a more stable source of livelihood.

However, because of insufficient opportunities, most of the communities are home to hundreds of unemployed parents and children who are unable to go to school.

Informal settlers relocated to new communities are either victims of natural disasters or those whose houses have been demolished in Metro Manila.















Relocation is not just a question of housing.

It's also a matter of alternative livelihood and food security in resettlement community.







We realized that a BASIC ENTREPRENEURSHIP TRAINING

would be very suitable to the relocated community.

In this way, the community would be equipped with skills needed for a sustainable source of livelihood.


