#### Evaluation

- → Evaluation of the photographs and arts will be taken place in mid April.
  - ♦ The judges will look for the certain criteria:
    - ♦ What is the picture?
    - ♦ How does it resemble peace?
    - → Is the artwork sensible?
    - ♦ Copyright issues.

# Judging of Contest

- ♦ The Judging of the contest would be done through the arts committee in my school's art department, and at other education art committees over Singapore.
  - ♦ The judging will go through several stages.
    - ♦ Stage 1: The UNESCO Youth Peace Festival ambassadors will make sure all the artwork is related to peace.
    - ♦ Stage 2: The sensible pictures will be sent to the art committee of each chosen institutions.
    - ♦ Stage 3: The art committees at each institutions will pick their best 5, and send it back to the UNESCO YPF ambassadors.
    - ♦ Stage 4: From there we pick which artwork was the most popular, and decide the winner.

# Budget of Contest

- → Budget is covered by registration fees.
- ♦ The judging is done through school institutions art departments, which will be covered by the schools.
- ♦ Part of the money will be given to the winners of the competition as an incentive.
