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## Statement of the problem

Bangladesh is a small country with large population. Most of the people in this country lives under the poverty line. Education and health facility are the basic needs of human beings. But Education is the most important catalyst for human development as well as achieving (MDG) goal.

Basically many children particularly the children from disadvantaged/underprivileged families remain deprived and are denied from fundamental rights like education and health.



## Besides... Vision Aid International

- Bangladesh has a population of 154.7 million and is one of the world's most densely populated countries.
- 50% of the population lives below the poverty line, 36% on less than \$1 a day.
- 42% below the poverty line are less than 18 years old and 11% are less than 5.
- The primary school dropout rate is 35%, with the primary reason being poverty and need to work.
- Nearly 5 million children between the ages of 5 and 15 are employed, most receiving little or no pay.
- 450,000 children live on the streets in Bangladesh.
- Widening income gaps give rise to trafficking and commercial exploitation of children. (Source: DCI-
