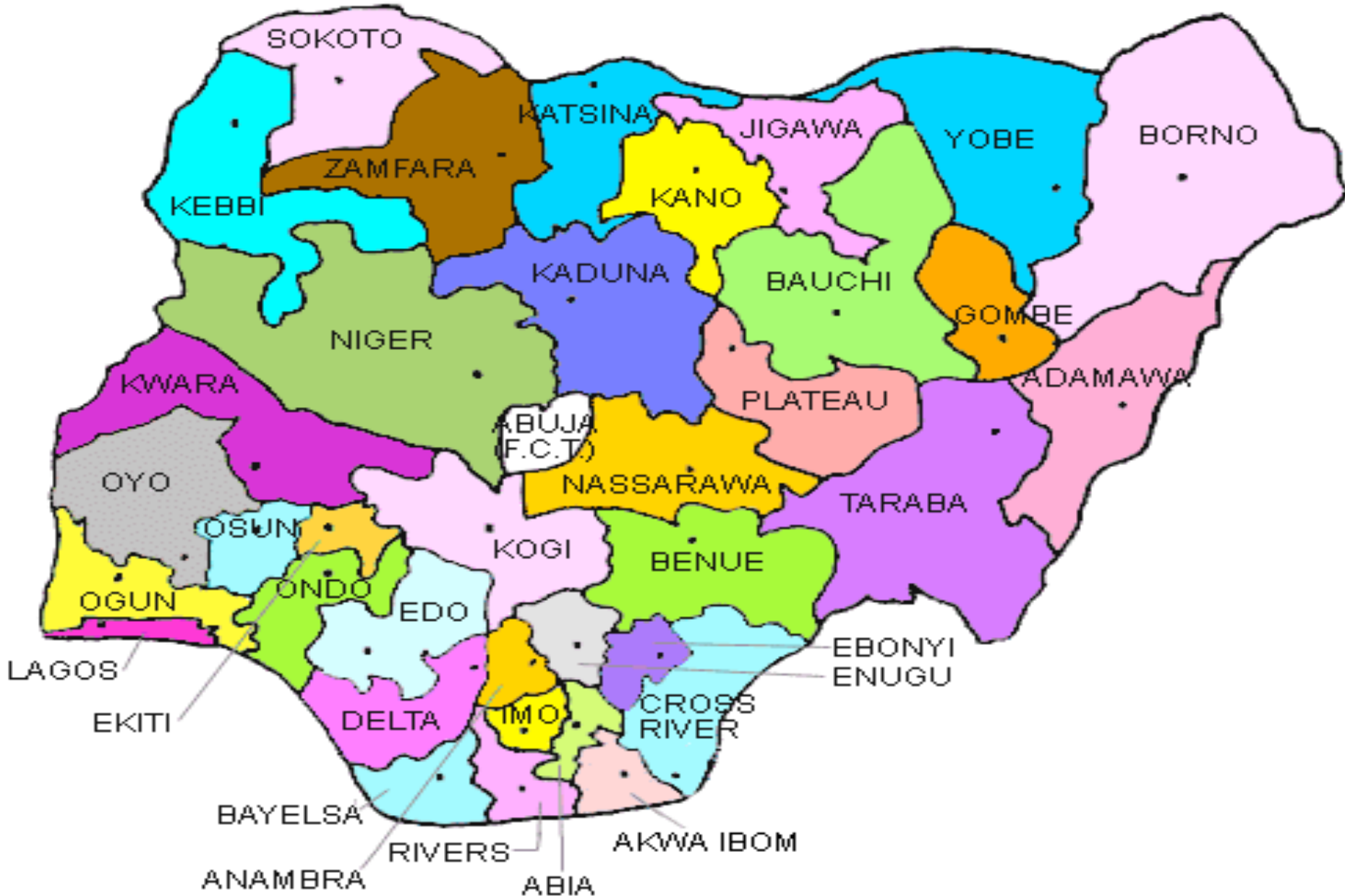


YOUTH EMPOWERMENT IN NIGERIA

PROBLEM STATEMENT

- Youth's unemployment leads to more crimes in our communities
 - When youth are not engaged they tend to loose of focus
 - Youths are not aware of the opportunities they have around them.
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OBJECTIVES

- ✘ To create awareness on sources of funds to start their micro enterprises and agricultural practices in Nigeria
- ✘ To create employment opportunities for youths through computer training

ACTIVITIES ON AWARENESS CREATION ON SOURCES OF FUND FOR MICRO ENTERPRISES

- This project will start with consultation to stakeholders (micro-finance Bank, local government, state government and federal government, beneficiaries community leaders, and other potential sponsors) to be identified in the area
- Publicity for the workshop
- Presentation by relevant scholar on sources of funding and micro enterprise business

ACTIVITIES ON EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES CREATION FOR YOUTHS THROUGH COMPUTER TRAINING

- ✘ Consultation with relevant stakeholders (government at all levels, schools and youths organisations)
- ✘ Publicity for the seminar
- ✘ Public awareness creation and selection of the trainees who shows interest
- ✘ Computer training for 3months for student and 1year for those seeking for admission into higher institutions. The curriculum for the training will contain computer application for employment creation, peace culture in our society through computer knowledge etc.

TIMELINE

- ✘ Awareness creation start in December, 2013 with advocacy visit to the relevant stake holders and awareness seminar start holds in January, 2013 which will be followed by follow up to ensue that the participant are able to acquire fund and start agro based business.
- ✘ Computer training will be start by identifying the youths who are literate academically before enrolling them. Five student for one year and maximum of ten student for three months programme.
