Pendidikan Politik Muda
(Youth Political Education)

BECAUSE

1 130 million people live in rural Indonesia. For 32 years in Orde Baru (before Reform era 1998), rural people was dissociated from their political right - used to think that politic have no benefit at all.

2 43 % people are under 25 years old. It's easier and long lasting to educate youth than senior citizen. Then I think, we have no comprehensive political education for young people yet.

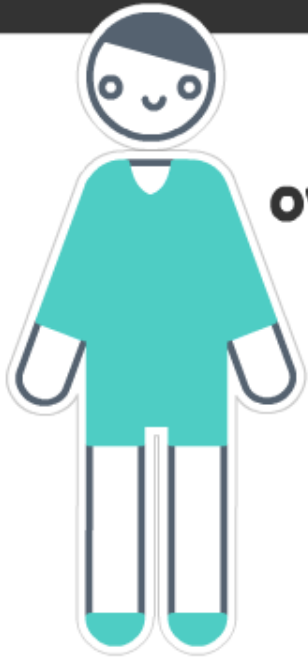

Mandala Madwandayudha; Mayor Candidates Debate

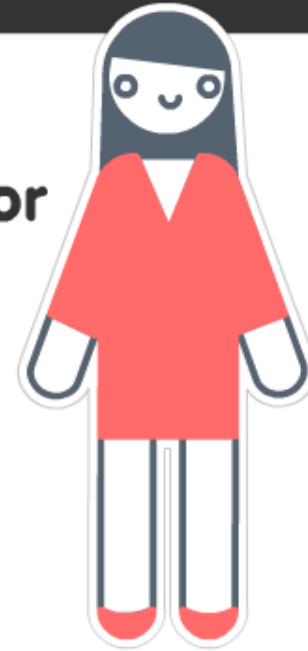

Timeline :

1. May 26-June 1 Pendidikan Politik Muda begin with full-week workshop for 52 local youth leaders.
2. June 28-30 Youth Local Summit; Youth consultation on local-global development agenda.
3. July 16-27; Rational Voters Campaign, for youth in rural to combat bribery practice during election.
4. August 24, Mandala Madwandayudha, Mayor Candidate Debate. Youth convey development agenda for future mayor.
5. September 8, Local Mayor Election happen, oversee the process from election to inauguration.
6. January 24, 2014 : Inaugurate local youth watchdog
