### **Problem Statement**

Tunisian Society has a major problem of the growing number of students consuming drugs. The statistics show that 40% of students between 15-20 years of age admit that they have used drugs at least once. They buy drugs in high schools.

#### Two major problems are:

- 2) The implementation of laws are not strict

### Objectives
