We consist of 4 castes and 36 ethnic groups, and different religious faiths, and they possess their own culture and tradition and some are becoming *extinct*.

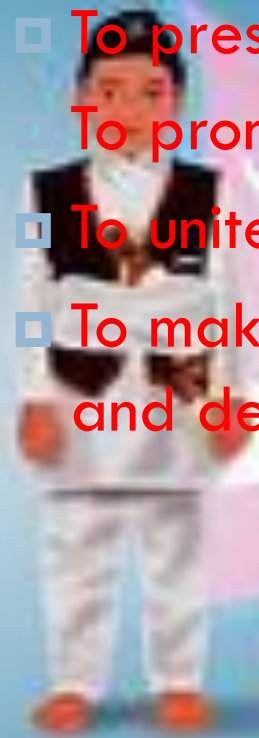
About the Program

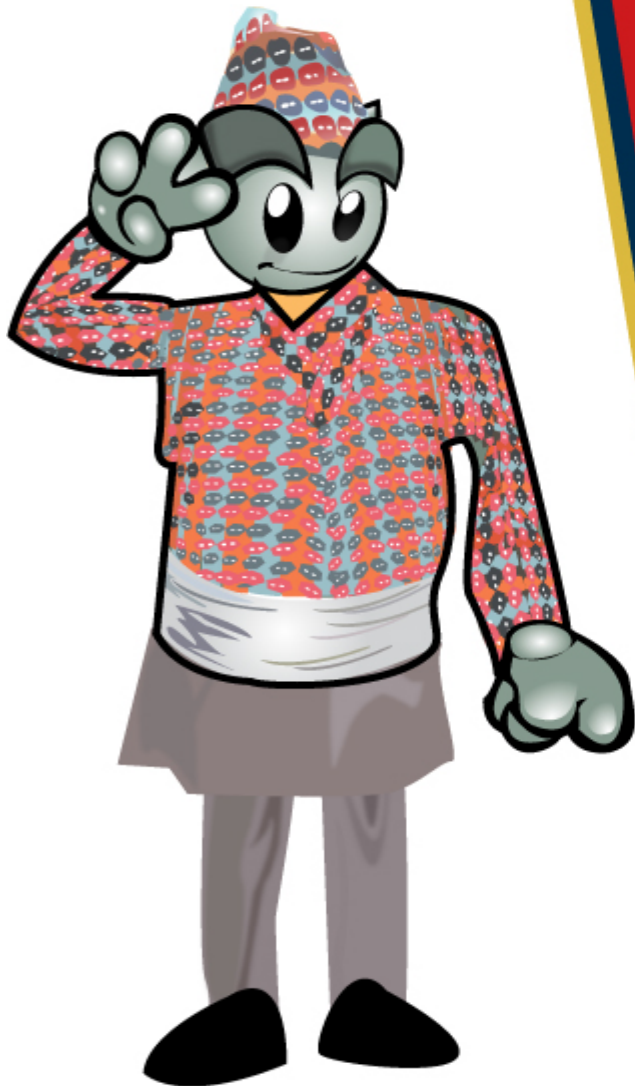
