What is this action plan about???

A video-making document to reflect back on the flooding situation in Cambodia.



Why???

- ❑ Both Cambodia and Thailand were affected from flooding in 2011. However, Cambodia was not a focus of attention.
- ❑ While the flooding in Thailand was more serious, Cambodia still had more than half of the number of deaths compared to Thailand (278/506 people).



Purposes

1. To address the flooding situation in Cambodia
2. To engage minority groups and the vulnerable people to overcome and express their thoughts over their situations
3. To draw attention of the community and the government to the areas affected by flooding and take possible preventing for later experiences.



When???

- Time frame: February, 2012

Specific Objectives
